VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES DURING THE SCHOOL DAY:

- Great Books** – facilitate small reading group discussions
- Art Adventure** – Teach art appreciation over an 8 week period. Training provided
- Lost and Found** – Return labeled clothing to its owner, perhaps find some of your own!
- Nurse's Office** – Staff the nurse's office (training provided, no nursing experience needed)
- Book Fair** – planning and staffing the book fair in November (day and weekend shifts)

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL DAY:

- Boxtops and Labels** – collect sort and clip General Mills Boxtops and Campbell Soup Labels
- Data Entry** – Enter data into Volunteer and Directory database
- Used Uniform Sales** – (Fall Registration Night in August)
- Specialty Apparel** – Take and distribute orders for Nativity Specialty Apparel
- Nativity School Apparel** – Take and distribute orders for Nativity Uniform Apparel

- Catholic Schools Week** – Ice Cream Social last week of January
- New Parent Tours** – Set up refreshments and/or assist on tours
- Mini Marathon** – Cheer on our young marathoners and serve a snack or two
- Marathon** – Cheer on our older marathoners and serve a snack or two

OUTSIDE OF THE SCHOOL DAY

- Kindergarten Round Up** – Set up refreshments and welcome prospective families
- Meet the Teacher** – help set up hospitality on one of two nights in September
- 8th Grade Graduation Dance** – Chaperone and set up. Parents of 8th graders are encouraged to assist with this event
- Graduation Reception** – Serve beverages and snacks to guests of our 8th graders on graduation night
